We've sparked their interest in a career in engineering and in the MINT sector.


We put them in direct contact with apprentices, students, professionals and experts in the field.

Technology and IT weeks

IngCH has been staging Technology and IT Weeks in secondary schools throughout Switzerland as part of its talent development programme since 1992. Each project week offers a range of different perspectives on engineers and MINT professions in general, raising interest in the field and helping to deepen understanding.





Meitli Technology Days

In cooperation with member and non-member companies, IngCH organises one or two-day Meitli Technology Days, during which the girls are offered an exciting programme of presentations, workshops and visits at the company. The offer is aimed at girls in the first and second year of lower secondary level.

«Achtung Technik Los!»

«Achtung Technik Los!» is a project to promote young talents at secondary level I, which counters the shortage of skilled workers in MINT professions and strengthens the dual education system in Switzerland. The offer takes place directly at schools and reaches all secondary school students in the career choice phase.

The MINT service centre offers schools personal advice on MINT queries and MINT projects. The goal is to pair up schools with appropriate services, develop new services and provide a bridge between business, research and academia. This results in individual MINT projects and MINT concepts designed around the school's specific needs.
